2. **ORDINANCE NO. 2011-706** AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, BOATS OR TRAILERS; AMENDING SECTION 30-101 BY ALLOWING PARKING IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOADING AND UNLOADING OF ONLY ONE VEHICLE, BOAT OR TRAILER DURING ONE CONTIGUOUS 48 HOUR PERIOD IN ANY 7 DAY PERIOD; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. FIRST READING.
