

Greetings from Town Hall

We are busy planning for our December Holiday Events. Please take note of the dates/times on the back of this page and please join us in celebrating the holidays.



Holiday Food Drive ~ There will be a town wide special holiday food drive for the Beach Community Food Pantry. Please donate non-perishable food at Town Hall between Monday, November 14th and Thursday, November 17th. We will deliver the donations to the food pantry on Friday which will make it available to local area families for the Thanksgiving holidays.

New Resident Parking Permits ~ New resident parking permits are now available at Town Hall. The new rear-view mirror hanging permits will replace the old ones that affixed to the vehicle's window. There is no fee for them and they will expire every 2 years. If you have the old red and white parking permit please bring it into Town Hall and it will be exchanged. If you currently do not have a resident parking permit, and would like to park at our six beach parking spaces, please stop by Town Hall with your driver's license to be issued one.



Pinellas County Sheriff's Office ~ The Sheriff's Office main telephone number is 582-6200. To request a deputy, call the main number and follow the voice prompts. Monday thru Friday 7:30 AM – 5:30 PM you can call Town Hall for a deputy. In any emergency situation always call 911 and state your emergency.

Garage Sale, Trailer/RV and Storage Pod Permits ~ All permits are issued at Town Hall at no charge. Garage sales are allowed for a maximum of 2 days, only twice a year, and not within 90 days of each other. A trailer/RV can be parked on your property for a period of 48 hours (in one 7 day period) without a permit. After 48 hours a permit is required and can be issued for up to 14 days every six months. Storage pods require a permit and are allowed for 7 days in any six month period.



Beach Renourishment Update ~ The sand cometh in March! The project will begin at Sand Key and work to the south. North Redington Beach will be at the end, possibly starting in August-September (depending on any weather delays).

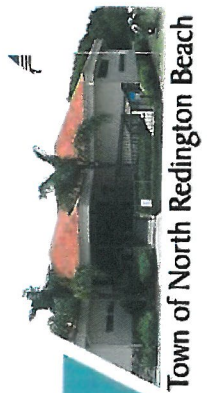


Pet Litter ~ Please help to keep our parks, streets and walkways clean and free of pet litter. It is unlawful for any person allowing a dog or cat to defecate or commit any other act consisting of a nuisance, on the land or premises of any person. If the dog or cat "goes" on the property of its owner, the waste must be removed and disposed of in a timely enough manner to keep it from becoming a nuisance. If the dog or cat "goes" on public property, the waste must be removed immediately and disposed of properly by the person in control of the animal. Everyone who walks their pet is required by Town Law (Ordinance Section 14-31 & 14-32) to have their pet leashed and to promptly remove dog/cat feces. Continued failure to pick up after your pet constitutes a nuisance and is a misdemeanor violation. Also, do not allow your pet(s) in the children's playground areas as this causes unsanitary conditions. Be a responsible citizen, please clean up after your pet.

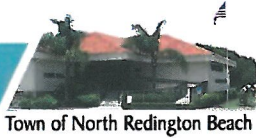
